Tips to Submit a Responsive Bid

- 1 Commercial qualification - Business registration, JV agreements etc
- 2 Evidence to prove experience
- 3 Translated documents in English Language (where original documents are produced in other languages)
- 4 Audited financial statements
- 5 All other documents requested in the Bid data sheet, bidding forms and employer's requirements
